Sponne Sixth Form Dress Code

Students **can wear** the following professional wear only:

Tops

- Collared shirt/blouse, plain polo shirts or plain t-shirts
- Option to wear a plain cardigan, jumper or waistcoat/suit jacket/blazer
- Coats/hoodies to be worn as outerwear only and should be removed when inside the school building
- NO slogans/images/large logos on any clothing, no sportswear

Bottoms

- Tailored/suit trousers
- Chinos/Smart cords
- Tailored/suit skirt
- Tailored/suit dress
- Smart shoes/boots only (e.g. brogues, flat pumps, ankle boots, desert boots, DM shoes/boots)
- NO denim, combat, leather/faux leather, tracksuit bottoms, gym wear, ripped clothing, heavy patterns. NO trainers Timberland/casual boots/shoes

Additional points:

- No large logos or branding to be worn on any clothing

- Hairstyles should be in keeping with smart dress ethos and shouldn't be dyed excessively bright colours
- Piercings should be subtle and not excessive
- No revealing clothing to be worn

Consequences

Students that choose to attend Sponne Sixth Form automatically agree to comply with the dress code above. Should a student not adhere to the dress code, the following consequences will be put in place. Sixth Form tutors will check dress code on a daily basis.

- 1) First offence - informal student warning to rectify - not logged.
- 2) Second offence - agreed time with tutor to rectify dress code issue and this is logged on Go 4 Schools. Students given one week to sort the issue.
- 3) Third offence - tutor to contact parents and this is logged. Parents made aware of the situation - tutors refer back to the dress code document above.

- 4) Continuous non-adherence to the dress code - social and study time becomes directed time until the parent/guardian meeting takes place. Parent/guardian meeting with Head of Sixth Form and SLT link/Headteacher.
- 5) Persistent failure following the meeting will lead to all social and study time becoming directed time until the student adheres to the code.
