#### • What is introspection and how is it relevant?

-Explain what is meant by the term introspection? -How does it link to Psychology as a science?

#### • Who is John B. Watson and what are his main ideas?

-Who is Watson and when was he writing?

-How is he different/similar to Wundt?

-What are his key ideas and how do they link to Psychology as a science?

#### <u>Conclusion</u>

-Is Psychology a science?
