Individual liberty	Students learn about diversity and therefore the freedom of others to live as they wish. Students are encouraged to ask questions, make independent choices, and to share their views on a range of topics.
Mutual Respect	Students develop their oracy skills through presentations and debates, therefore learning to listen respectfully to each other and to consider others' point of view.
Democracy VOTE	Students learn about political systems in the UK when they study the Education topic in Year 12. Democracy is one of the key words they study.
Freedom of faiths and beliefs	Students learn about different religious and cultural beliefs, particularly during the unit on The Family as well as Beliefs in Society.
The rule of law	Students learn about different laws, particularly in the Crime and Deviance unit. They find out about different methods of social control.
